Members admitted to practice in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, but have neither an office or residence in Worcester County, who are in good standing and active status with the Board of Bar Overseers shall be entitled to vote but may not hold any office in the association unless they have been dues-paying members for six consecutive years.

** An Associate Membership is a person not a member of the bar who is a paralegal holding a certificate as such from any accredited program for the training of paralegals; or who is a law clerk, title examiner, constable or member of the staff of any regular member of the association in good standing, or any governmental body, including but not limited to the courts in the Commonwealth, both state and federal; or any person employed by any person or company providing professional services that align with the business interests of association members or the mission of the association may become an associate of the association upon payment of the annual dues.

*** A Retired Membership is an attorney with an inactive status with the BBO.

Associate and Law Student members may not vote nor hold any office in the Association.
